# Monterey Handcar Railbike Tour & Coastal Walk

Saturday, July 12th 8:15 AM - 3:30 PM Handcar Tours - Marina, CA

Residents are invited to explore the scenic beauty of Fort Ord Dunes State Park through a guided railbike tour. This six-mile round-trip journey travels along historic railroad tracks using handcars and electric-assist railbikes. The experience lasts approximately 1 hour and 45 minutes, with each railbike accommodating two people. The cost is \$152.00 per pair.

For those seeking a more relaxed outing, you can walk along the Monterey Bay Coastal Trail, which runs parallel to the railroad tracks and provides breathtaking views at a gentler pace. After the handcar tour or coastal walk, participants will have the opportunity to enjoy lunch and explore Fisherman's Wharf in Monterey.
